Skill Enhancement

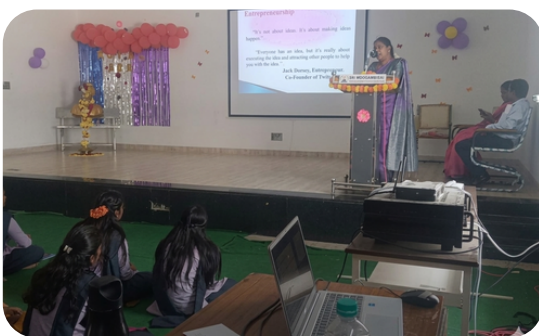
20/02/2026

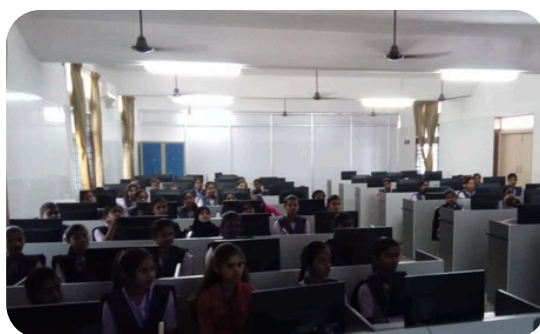

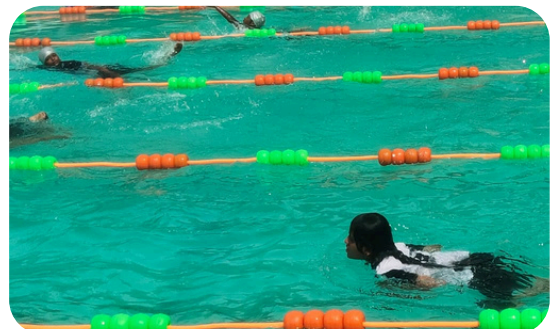


CM – Trophy
